The five learning outcomes for the course are: the legal framework; roles and powers of workplace parties; role of HSR; identification of hazards and controls; and consultation, issue resolution and negotiation skills. East Gippsland TAFE is the approved training provider for this course with the Victorian Workcover Authority.

Rigging - Basic

This basic course combines the skills of a Dogger with additional training. This program enables the successful participant to use lifting gear to shift large items of plant and be involved in the safe erection of steel work. The course structure covers planning, tools and equipment, moving plant and equipment, erecting steel structures, placing pre-cast concrete, and the skills needed to erect, inspect, alter or repair mast climbers.

Pre-requisite: The successful completion of Dogging is required prior to enrolment in this course.

This program permits the successful participant to be involved in erecting tilt-up concrete slabs, all kinds of demolition work and the lifting of loads where two or more cranes are required. Once this course is completed, students will be assessed for a National Certificate of Competency.

Pre-requisite: The successful completion of Rigging - Basic is required prior to enrolment in this course.
